



Finding your way to Jacques Hall

By Train - There are trains from London Liverpool Street Station to Manningtree Station. Journey time of approximately 1 hour – trains currently run every half hour. There is also a train service from Ipswich and Norwich to Manningtree.

From the South - Leave M25 at Junction 28 – link to A12 signposted Chelmsford/Colchester. Continue on A12 by-passing Chelmsford and Colchester. After approximately 35 miles take A120 signposted Clacton/Harwich. Continue for approximately 7 miles to Horsley Cross Roundabout. Take left exit heading towards Manningtree. After approximately 1½ miles you will see an aerial mast on your right. At this mast turn right into Steam Mill Road. This will bring you into the village of Bradfield. Continue straight through the village until you come to the Parish Church on your right and the Strangers Home Pub on your left. Turn right into Harwich Road. On leaving the village, the road winds round several bends. After approximately ¼ mile turn left between farm building on sharp right hand bend. Jacques Hall is situated along this small private road which is shared with the farm. (Take care over the speed ramps.)

From the North - Travel to A14 (formerly the A45) heading towards Ipswich/Felixstowe. At Ipswich take A137 turn off (the last exit off the roundabout) heading towards Brantham/Manningtree at Brantham. Pass over the river Stour and then under the railway bridge which brings you to a roundabout. Take the 3rd exit and go up the hill. At the mini roundabout (Service Station opposite) turn left and travel along this road for about 1 mile. Turn right (signposted Clacton/A120). Travel for approximately 2-3 miles. Turn left (signposted Bradfield – just before the aerial mast which will be ahead on your left) into Steam Mill Road. This will bring you into the village of Bradfield. Continue straight through the village until you come to the Parish Church on your right and the Strangers Home Pub on your left. Turn right into Harwich Road. On leaving the village, the road winds round several bends. After approximately ¼ mile turn left between farm building on sharp right hand bend. Jacques Hall is situated along this small private road which is shared with the farm. (Take care over the speed ramps.)
