



Finding your way to Rossendale School

From M62/M60 - Leave at Junction 18 on to M66 and follow directions below from M66.

From M66 - Leave at Junction 1 signposted Ramsbottom A56. At the traffic lights at the end of the sliproad turn right onto the A56. Continue for approximately 2 miles into the village of Edenfield. At the mini roundabout with a pub on the left called the Rostron Arms turn right (back on yourself) signposted Rochdale A680. Climb up through Turn Village for approximately 2½ miles. The road straightens out and at the end of the straight there is 'Slow' marked on the road and a triangular school sign on the left. Turn right into a farm track – there is a directional sign to Rossendale School at the entrance. Follow the track until it divides into two, take the right hand fork onto tarmac. We are at the end of the tarmac. The main entrance is on the gable end of the new school building, at the foot of the steps. Please report to the office on arrival to sign in.

From M65 - Follow signs for the M66/Bury & Manchester. Exit the dual carriageway at the 'Motorway Ahead' exit, signposted A676 Ramsbottom & Bolton and A680 Edenfield & Rochdale and follow signs for Edenfield. Turn 1st left off the slip road and follow road to T junction and then turn left again. You will come to a mini roundabout with a pub on the left called the Rostron Arms turn right (back on yourself) signposted Rochdale A680. Climb up through Turn Village for approximately 2½ miles. The road straightens out and at the end of the straight there is 'Slow' marked on the road and a triangular school sign on the left. Turn right into a farm track – there is a directional sign to Rossendale School at the entrance. Follow the track until it divides into two, take the right hand fork onto tarmac. We are at the end of the tarmac. The main entrance is on the gable end of the new school building, at the foot of the steps. Please report to the office on arrival to sign in.

NB - If you are using Sat Nav you cannot access the school from the A56 and need to use the A680.
