Life Works eating disorder day care programme

At Life Works, we recognise the impact that an eating disorder has on all aspects of a person's daily life. As such, our in-person day care programme aims to support you holistically, focusing on the psychological, social, behavioural and physical aspects of your eating disorder.

Together, our multidisciplinary team provides a specialist day care programme using evidence-based therapeutic interventions. Our goal is to provide you with the tools to promote and sustain your recovery journey, all with minimal impact on your daily life.

Our programme

Before admission onto the day care programme, clients will go through our free therapy assessment, where we will introduce ourselves and our programme, and discuss goals and expectations for each person before they engage with the programme.

Everyone's experience with their eating disorder is unique, and this assessment process will allow us to develop a comprehensive and bespoke treatment plan with each person, to address their needs and goals.

If you're self-funding and choose the executive or premium day care packages, you will have a £40 reduction on cost per meal if you cannot attend either breakfast or dinner.

We also offer a discount of 10% to self-funding clients who pay for 20 days of treatment up front.

Additional costs:

Any clients who need support over and above what's included in the package may access this, subject to additional costs. These include:

- + Additional individual therapy - £155 (50 minutes)
- + Additional occupational therapy - £155 (50 minutes)
- + Additional dietetic review - £155 (50 minutes)



Family support

We recognise how important it is for clients to have their family members/partners/friends involved in their recovery journey. As such, we endeavour to include family as much as possible, should a client want us to. We offer clients and their loved ones the opportunity to attend a family support group/programme as follows:

- + Family support programme - this is 1 hour per week and conducted remotely for any family members who wish to join, while you're on the day care programme
- + Family programme - this takes place on-site and is available to any client choosing the deluxe package or above. Your family will receive an invite to this during your day care programme
- + Family conjoint - this can take place on-site or remotely and is available to any client choosing the deluxe package or above

Who can we support?

- + Adults aged 18 years and older
- + People suffering from anorexia nervosa, binge eating disorder (BED), bulimia nervosa, other specified feeding or eating disorders (OSFED) and avoidant restrictive food intake disorder (ARFID)
- + People in need of support with weight restoration

The team that will support you

- + Consultant psychiatrist
- + Occupational therapist
- + Therapist
- + Healthcare assistants
- + Therapy assistants
- + Dietitian

12.30pm – 1.15pm	Lunch with table support
1.15pm – 1.45pm	Post-meal support
2pm – 3pm	Group therapy
3pm – 3.10pm	Afternoon snack with table support
3.20pm – 4.20pm	Group therapy
4.20pm – 6pm	Free time
6pm – 6.45pm	Dinner with table support
6.45pm – 7.15pm	Post-meal support

Further information

You'll be assigned a consultant psychiatrist to oversee your care while you attend day care at Life Works. You may need an assessment with one of our consultants prior to starting the programme. If you're funding the programme with private medical insurance (PMI), your consultant will send off your funding forms to the insurance company you're with. Our team will then update you once we've received confirmation that funding is in place.

Following your acceptance into our day care programme, we'll advise you on the amount of days we feel you should attend. The therapy team and consultant will also continue to review your progress while you're with us. Should further weeks be advised and you are funding with PMI, then your consultant will send off your renewal forms.
