Mental Health services

Priory Woodland View is a 31-bedded locked rehabilitation and recovery service for men requiring a positive environment to develop positive self-management and independent skills for a successful discharge into the community.

Based in the centre of England, we offer true holistic care through our specially formulated Clinical Programmes. The hospital is set in a rural location and offers a perfect environment to reintegrate back into the community.



Service overview

The hospital comprises of three separate wards:

- + **Elkin** provides 10 en-suite bedrooms and is led by a medical model with a focus on engagement and individual needs assessments
- + **Arley** consists of 10 en-suite bedrooms and introduces community facing skills and is led by a psychology model offering development of relapse prevention skills and symptom management
- + **Millison** is situated over 2 floors offering 11 en-suite bedrooms and delivers the opportunity to practice independent living skills and focus on engagement outside of the hospital in order to provide a seamless transition into the community

We provide a comfortable, spacious and homely setting with individually tailored rehabilitation and recovery programmes, offering intensive one-to-one and group occupational activities and psychotherapy with additional 24 hour nursing support and 24 hour consultant psychiatrist on-call cover.

Woodlands View specialises in complex and enduring mental health needs including conditions such as:

- + Mood disorders
- + Treatment resistant psychosis
- + Personality disorder
- + Post-traumatic stress disorder and trauma related conditions

Our service is suitable for informal patients and those under the Mental Health Act.



The environment

Our service is driven by three different models of care for our three units, from assessment and treatment through to simulated community environment.

We offer a multi-faith room and have strong links with religious faculties to address spiritual needs. We also have good professional links with the local Parish Council, the police service and safeguarding teams.

Situated in the main building we have a therapy block which offers facilities such as:

- + A skills kitchen
- + IT room
- + Gym
- + A comprehensive outdoor programme including use of our Polytunnel

Our team

Our patients are part of our team at Woodland View. We work together to build the confidence and skills to re-join a meaningful place in the community, or just as often, start afresh. Our professional expert team includes:

- + A structured nursing team
- + A clinical psychologist
- + Occupational therapists
- + A horticultural therapist
- + Social workers

- + Practice nurses
- + Health care practitioners

Treatment programme

Our recovery-based approach helps patients learn how to cope with difficulties, gain control of their life and make safe and healthy choices. Patients work closely with the team, their families (where appropriate) and access activities in the community. Our focus is to provide a safe and caring environment with effective care delivery and strong leadership:

- + Discharge plans are developed on admission offering clear plans of the pathway to leave the hospital
- + Patient involvement is at the heart of teamwork for us and there are opportunities to get involved in user forums, least restrictive practice groups and community meetings
- + Opportunities are sought in the local community to build structure, skills and education, leading to self-sufficiency and reduction in risk profile
- + Flexibility in delivering a care pathway structured around the needs of the individual, however complex they may be
- + We invest in our staff teams to ensure that our patients are delivered the most beneficial and appropriate care tailored to their needs

We operate an open and transparent service and welcome involvement from family and carers as well as professional colleagues through our families and carers diary, offering regular opportunities to meet with the multidisciplinary team and visit our site.
