Priory Lakeside View cares for adults of working age with acute mental health care needs within a safe, therapeutic environment in Willenhall, West Midlands.

We aim to provide a person-centred approach that promotes collaborative care planning to optimise treatment goals. From the point of admission into our acute services, we aim to support patients' safe discharge back into the community where they can continue to progress towards recovery in a less restrictive environment.

The aim of our service is to act as an extension to NHS care pathways during times of fluctuating capacity and flow, allowing many patients to receive care and treatment closer to home. This will provide continuity of care and aim to minimise disruption to patients and their loved ones.

Service overview

Priory Lakeside View is a 28-bedded facility, split between the following units:

- + 8-bedded female acute ward
- + 8-bedded male acute ward
- + 12-bedded male acute ward

Patient profile

Priory Lakeside View is suitable for patients who fit the following profile:

- + Working age adults who require treatment for their mental illness
- + Present with behaviours that challenge, including self-harm
- + Informal and formal patients detained under the Mental Health Act, subject to Ministry of Justice Restrictions or Deprivation Safeguards
- + Patients requiring a period of stabilisation before commencing their rehabilitation programme
- + Those needing a safe and secure therapeutic environment to reduce risk to themselves and/or others and build the skills for independence
- + Patients requiring structured treatment with the right balance between therapeutic and social activities

Our team

Our multidisciplinary team includes:

- + Psychology
- + Psychiatry
- + Nursing
- + Occupational therapy

Treatment programme

Our aim is to stabilise patients and to facilitate their safe return to the community (where appropriate). This is achieved by:

- + Thorough assessment of individuals' needs throughout admission
- + Person centred collaborative treatment plans
- + A range of interventions available from a diverse multidisciplinary team, combining psychiatric and cognitive behavioural perspectives with occupational therapy, psychology, leisure and recreational activity
- + Being cared for in the least restrictive environment

There are three acute wards on site; each ward provides patients with excellent space and facilities, including en-suite bedrooms and large living spaces furnished with activity equipment such as game consoles.

Outside of the wards, a purpose-built therapy suite contains a rehabilitation kitchen for patient cooking sessions, and a sessional therapy room. The hospital is set in the centre of an extensive nature reserve, which also houses an abundance of fauna and flora.

The clinical team at Lakeside View encourage full involvement of each individual, their family and external professionals throughout their stay. Individuals are invited to attend ward reviews and care planning approach (CPA) meetings to ensure clear communication throughout the care pathway in order to promote their recovery and facilitate discharge.
