### Brain Injury Services

Through our services at Egerton Road, East Sussex, we specialise in caring for adults with an acquired brain injury (ABI). We have created an environment that focuses on individual, slow-stream care to help transition residents into community living.

#### Service overview

Egerton Road supports adults with an ABI in a family-like environment, set within a residential space. We have created the ideal setting for the people we support to practice independent living with the aim of returning to living in the community, where appropriate.



#### Treatment programme

All of our care plans are tailored to individual needs and provide guidelines for everyday life. Support workers provide 24-hour guidance and assistance, one-to-one and group activities, including cooking and daily living skills.

We hold regular care and support plan reviews to evaluate achievements and identify further plans for development.

#### Resident profile

Egerton Road is suitable for those who meeting the following criteria:

- Males and females aged 18 years and over

Who have:

- An acquired brain injury
- Congenital conditions
- Had a stroke

## The team

Our services employ a comprehensive multidisciplinary team.

The team includes:

- Experienced service manager
- Specialist support workers
- Consultant neuropsychologist
- Psychology assistant
- Occupational therapist
- Residents have access to a visiting GP who can refer them to speech and language therapists, physiotherapists, occupational therapists, and dietitians

## An environment supporting recovery

Egerton Road is a small residential home, which provides a lively and supportive environment. It is situated in Bexhill on Sea, Sussex, just a short walk from the town centre and sea front.

Our general facilities include:

- 9 bedrooms utilising communal bathrooms
- 1 bedroom with en-suite facilities
- 1 self-contained transitional living unit (comprising of a bed-sit with bathroom and kitchen) adjoining the main building
- Family room
- Sitting room
- Dining/activities room
- Internet access for resident's computers
- Laundry
- Fully enclosed patio



## Transition to community living


Egerton Road helps residents in their neurorehabilitation treatment and helps them develop important independent living skills. To help assist this process we offer our residents the following activities:

- Supported education
- Adult education
- Voluntary work placements
- Attending day centres
- Workshop placements
- Various sporting and social activities

Once our residents have graduated to community living and leave Egerton Road, we offer outreach services to ensure continued support and care. When the people we support move out of the local area in East Sussex we work with external providers and outreach services to ensure they continue to receive support while they transition back into community living.
