Secure mental health services

Burston House provides low secure care and specialised treatment for men aged 18 years and older with a learning disability. Patients may also have other associated conditions including personality disorders, mental illnesses and autistic spectrum disorders (ASDs).

This service is part of a care pathway in Norfolk and Suffolk, which together, has a total of 97 beds in four linked specialised hospitals/units. They provide therapeutic security at different levels of need.



Treatment programme

Our treatment programme includes:

- **Assessment and motivational work**
- **Foundation**
- **Offence-specific support**
- **Personality Disorder symptom reduction**
- **Consolidation**
- **Relapse prevention**
- **Preparation for discharge and follow-up care**

Low secure:

St John's House, Bure Ward - 11 beds (female only)

St John's House, Waveney Ward - six beds (female only)

Burston House, Kestrel Ward, Rectory Ward and Eagle Ward - 31 beds (male only)

Medium secure:

St John's House, Walsham Ward - 16 beds (male only)

St John's House, Redgrave Ward - 16 beds (female only)

Community locked rehabilitation:

Lombard House - nine beds (male only)

Richmond House - eight beds (female only)

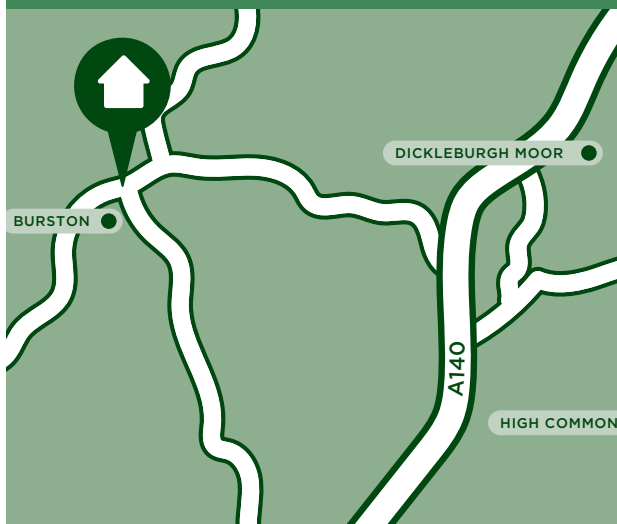
This service is suitable for:
