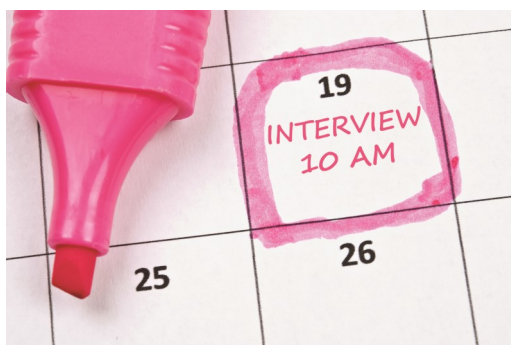
EMPLOYMENT SKILLS:

INTERVIEWING SKILLS

This is a single workshop that demonstrates the correct way to conduct yourself during an interview, in order to make a good first impression. This will be demonstrated through:

- ◆ Videos
- ◆ Role play
- ◆ Group interaction

This workshop lasts for around 45 to 60 minutes.



If you have already achieved an Open College Network (OCN) Entry Level 3 (or higher) qualification in literacy, there will be the opportunity to work towards taking the following OCN Entry Level 3 qualification:

- ◆ 'Communication—Preparation for an Interview'.

If you choose to work towards gaining this additional OCN, there will be a further 4 x one hour workshops in the classroom, held on a Wednesday.



In order to attend this workshop you must have the appropriate section 17 leave to the classroom in the stable block.
