Rehabilitation and transitional services

Located in Stroud, this residential home offers a viable alternative to a hospital or secure setting. It achieves this through a high ratio of care, which enables a robust and proactive approach to risk management, whilst supporting people to engage with meaningful activity in the community.

We are a 4-bedded rehabilitation and transitional service for males and females aged between 17 and 24 years with complex mental health and risk taking behaviours. This provision is part of Priory's Transitional Living Services for Young People and Young Adults, offering individuals the best possible care in their recovery journey.

Service overview

This service provides fully integrated packages of rehabilitative care, individually tailored to meet the specific needs of the young person, with a patient's own identified goals central to the strategy. These packages of care acknowledge and promote psychosocial development and reintegration into the wider community.

Individual therapy informs the wider treatment plan, collaboratively developing clear and precise plans with the young person, to help them achieve their goals.

We also provide access to an education hub, located in South Gloucestershire and Stroud College. This offers a supportive educational model within a mainstream environment which is carefully managed by our occupational therapy team.



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The residents gel with our staff and we promote normality. Former patients even come to visit, sometimes with their own children, and they meet with residents to offer advice and support.

The team

The home is led by the registered manager and deputy manager, and is supported by a multidisciplinary team of mental health professionals.

The team comprises of:

- + Psychiatrist
- + Therapies lead/Psychotherapist
- + Systemic psychotherapist
- + Art psychotherapist
- + Clinical psychologist
- + Lead occupational therapist
- + Occupational therapist
- + Occupational therapy assistants
- + The care team is divided as follows:
- + Care co-ordinator
- + Senior therapeutic care workers
- + Therapeutic care workers
- + Waking night therapeutic care workers

An environment suited to recovery

Bisley Lodge is a detached house in the village of Stancombe, in Gloucestershire. Stancombe has easy access to both the M4 and M5 motorways and the town offers good local facilities as well as easy access to the beautiful Stroud Valleys and Cotswolds.

The home has two cars for the provision of transport to Stroud where local facilities include Stroud College, Leisure Centre and various shopping and entertainment options. The cars are also available for assisting home visits for the children and young people.
