 Birmingham Airport and Birmingham New Street train station


Treatments

Our inpatient treatment programme is tailored to the specific needs of the individual, ensuring the best possible outcomes. We provide an evidence-based programme that is tailored to individual needs, all structured within National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guidelines.

- + Specialist addiction treatment programme, which includes support for alcohol, drugs, gambling, porn, internet and shopping addictions
- + Free aftercare for a year for addiction patients who complete the 28-day programme
- + Addiction treatment is delivered on an inpatient basis, and based on the 12-Step programme of Alcoholics Anonymous (AA). During treatment, patients have access to local AA and/or Narcotics Anonymous (NA) meetings

Specialist therapies include:

- + Integrative therapy
- + Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) programmes for anxiety and depression
- + Eye movement desensitisation and reprocessing (EMDR)
- + Interpersonal therapy



- + Individual weekly sessions provided by ward staff
- Transport to local support groups
- Therapeutic handbooks and activities to be completed during inpatient stays, to support with embedding therapy
- + Psycho-educational advice offered by members of the multidisciplinary team, on request

Family support

- Family programme is available
- Free family support for 12 months, during aftercare as part of the addiction treatment programme

Wellbeing activities

- + Group exercise classes
- Group yoga
- 1:1 yoga and personal training is available at an additional
- Access to holistic and complementary therapies available at an additional cost
- Seasonal ward activities frequently arranged by the ward staff
- + Menu planning with dietetic advice
- + Gardening in the grounds
