Specialist addiction treatment programme

We provide an evidence-based programme that is tailored to individual needs, all structured within National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guidelines. The full 28-day residential treatment programme offers:

- + Group therapy
- + Individual 1:1 therapy
- + Family group therapy
- + Couples therapy
- + Holistic treatment such as art therapy and yoga
- + Step-down pathway from inpatient to day care to ensure a smooth transition towards discharge
- + Free aftercare for 12 months on completion of the programme includes support groups, talks, advice and useful contacts
- + Approach underpinned by the renowned 12-step model

Priory Hospital Altrincham is a 'dry centre' that promotes recovery by providing people with the coping strategies to recognise and, in time, overcome their substance misuse or addictive behaviours.

We provide support for the following types of addictions:

- + Alcohol
- + Drugs, including new psychoactive and illicit substances
- + Gambling
- + Love and sex
- + Shopping
- + Food
- + Internet

We are also able to offer a comprehensive, medically assisted detoxification process for drug and alcohol addictions, as required, delivered in a safe and controlled environment. Our medically assisted detox programme is the safest and most effective way to detox.

We offer a free addiction assessment which provides you with the opportunity to:

- + Meet face-to-face with a member of the addiction treatment team
- + Talk through your proposed addiction treatment plan
- + Ask any questions that you may have



Mental health treatment programmes

Priory Hospital Altrincham's groupbased and individual psychotherapy programmes have been specifically designed to treat a wide range of mental health conditions. We use a range of therapeutic methods, including:

- + Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT)
- + Dialectical behaviour therapy (DBT)
- Eye movement desensitisation and reprocessing (EMDR) - specialised treatment for post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- + Mindfulness
- + Interpersonal therapy (IPT)
- + Schema-focused therapy, which combines aspects of CBT, interpersonal and psychoanalytic therapies

Our individualised treatment programmes can offer you expert support for a wide range of mental health conditions, including:

- + Depression
- + Anxiety
- + Stress
- + PTSD
- + Anger management issues
- + Phobias
- + Self-harm
- + Bipolar disorder
- + Bereavement and grief counselling
- + Seasonal affective disorder (SAD)
