We are able to deliver specialist treatment for the following eating disorders:

- + Anorexia nervosa
- + Bulimia nervosa
- + Binge eating disorder (BED)
- + Other specified feeding or eating disorders (OSFED)

Programmes

We are able to provide a range of treatment options, selected according to the level of support that is required. We offer:

- + 28 to 42 day inpatient treatment programmes that provide intensive support (programmes can be longer if needed)
- + A day care programme that enables clients to participate in our robust programme while returning home each evening
- + Outpatient support for those requiring step-down or less intensive support. Clients are able to make flexible appointments with our consultant psychiatrists and therapists

Our programme is able to flex to the specific needs of each individual in our care. We are able to offer placements for:

- + Adults (both male and female)
- + With an eating disorder (anorexia, bulimia, BED or OSFED)

- + Maudsley Model of Anorexia Nervosa Treatment for Adults (MANTRA)
- + Body image groups/acceptance workshops
- + Dance movement psychotherapy groups
- + Psychoeducational groups, such as:
 - Understanding emotions
 - Relapse prevention

Access to other proven therapies and groups:

- + Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) informed groups
- + Art informed therapy and mindfulness
- + Access to Anorexics and Bulimics Anonymous (ABA) meetings
