

Attention deficit hyperactivity disorder (ADHD) assessments for young people

Priory Hospital Chelmsford offers fast access to private ADHD assessments and diagnoses for young people, between the ages of 6 and 17, who are showing signs of ADHD. These are delivered by our specialist child and adolescent psychiatrists, who are experts in the field.

Our ADHD assessments are available for £1,500 and we offer significantly shorter waiting times than the national average.

The process for Priory Hospital Chelmsford's ADHD assessment is as follows:

GP referral



Developmental assessment - this involves meeting the young person and their parents/guardians, to discuss their developmental history. Schools will also be sent a questionnaire to complete



Conners rating scales - questionnaires used to assess ADHD symptoms in children across different settings, such as home and school. These will be emailed out to the relevant people following the developmental assessment



Feedback session - to discuss the outcomes of the ADHD assessment and provide any recommendations for further support



Outcomes report - detailing any diagnosis that was reached, and recommendations. This report can also be sent to schools/colleges, if necessary
