- The full care pathway offered, allows patients to move through to the next stage of their treatment in a timely manner
- We admit patients with highly challenging presentations and are able to move them through their care pathway quickly because of the quality of interventions offered
- Provision of high quality mental health care, and a focus on physical healthcare for all patients. A GP service three days a week is supported by a physical health team, who provide clinics for patients such as clozapine, retinopathy, triage for physical health issues and emergencies. A Hepatitis C clinic enables patients to become symptom-free
- We offer a 12-week rolling care and treatment programme for our patients, which is reviewed and evaluated by a multidisciplinary team
- We have good links with the local general hospital and community services

- We offer high quality assessment, treatment and rehabilitation services for adults with complex mental health needs, serious mental illness, including treatment-resistant presentations, and challenging behaviour
- We expect continued involvement and engagement with local services at every stage of the patient's pathway. This is particularly important in relation to risk reduction, rehabilitation, social integration and discharge planning
- Our 12-week care planning process supports patients to prioritise their goals and formulate treatment plans to meet their individual needs and recovery. Care planning is being developed further to adopt a positive behaviour support (PBS) model, helping patients gain more insight and recognise triggers for their behaviours with the aim of managing these more effectively
- Many staff have worked here for almost 10 years. The team have an excellent understanding of our patients and develop professional, therapeutic and purposeful relationships that nurture a safe and effective environment
- Staff training is central to our service development and we exceed contractual obligations for both NHS England and NHS Wales
