Treatment programmes

Our group-based and individual psychotherapy programmes have been specifically designed to treat a wide range of mental health conditions. We provide evidence-based treatment that is tailored to individual needs, all structured within National Institute for Health and Care Excellence (NICE) guidelines. Our private adult services include:

- + A comprehensive and abstinence-based addiction treatment programme
- + Medically assisted detoxification (inpatient addiction patients only)
- + Aftercare for a year after discharge for addiction patients
- + Free addiction assessment
- + Cognitive behavioural therapy (CBT) programmes for anxiety and depression
- + Eye movement desensitisation and reprocessing (EMDR) for post-traumatic stress disorder (PTSD)
- + Schema-focused therapy
- + Interpersonal psychotherapy
- + Dialectical behaviour therapy (DBT)

Our private young people's services include:

- + Outpatient psychiatric and psychological support for children and adolescents with a wide range of mental health difficulties
